

WELD COUNTY FOOTBALL LEAGUE PARTICIPANT RULES

The Weld County Football League Board of Directors has established a minimum guideline of rules, which we expect the young men and women who participate in the league to abide by. To eliminate any misunderstanding, the following rules and the form are to be signed and returned to your respective coach.

Realizing the need for some guidance, league participants will be expected to honor the following rules throughout the season. The rules will be in effect the first day of practice, until completion of the season's competition.

PARTICIPANT RULES:

1. Participants will conduct themselves in a responsible manner. Realizing that as participants, they represent the Weld County Football League and their respective organizations.
2. Use of drugs will not be permitted unless required for medical reasons. Tobacco and alcohol will not be tolerated.
3. Participants will respect the rights of opponents and treat them with up most respect.
4. Participants will respect the rights of teammates and treat them with up most respect.
5. Participants will be required to attend all practices and games unless excused for death in the family, illness, or other absence considered excusable by the coach.
6. Use of obscene gestures and language will not be tolerated.
7. All fees, completed and physical forms will be turned in before a participant will be allowed to begin practice or play in games. This rule will be strictly enforced.
8. Participants will be responsible for the uniform checked out to him/her. If not turned in at the end of the season- within 14 days, the participant will be billed the cost of replacement (\$300.00). Also, any damage above and beyond normal use will be assessed and the participant will be charged accordingly.
9. Participants' school grades will be maintained at passing level. The coach retains the right to bench a player who does not comply with this role.
10. Participants will be expected to honor any other roles established by the coach for the season.
11. Any rules not complied with could result in dismissal from the team.

It is hoped that the attitude of the participant and parent towards the above policies will be positive; viewing these rules as necessary and reasonable guidelines set down for the benefit of the Weld County Football League, team, and individual player.
